



Soo Pee Wee Hockey League

If you plan on applying to a subsidy program you must register using the SPWHL online registration system. You will be required to pay a \$100 deposit (Timbits 4-Atom) and \$200 deposit (Pee Wee) per child at the time of registration. After you register please bring or send a copy of your subsidy application to the Administrator at the SPWHL office. At that point your child will be placed on a draft team. If you are sending a copy via email send it to administrator@soopeewee.ca or drop it off to our office located at the back entrance of the Soo Pee Wee Arena, 285 Northern Ave. E.

Once payment from the subsidy organization is received, the money will be applied to your outstanding balance (registration/team fees). If funds remain then your \$100 deposit will be refunded to you.

Below is some information on different options that are available, along with common questions people have when inquiring about subsidy programs.

Max amount anyone can receive?

The Big Play provides funding of up to \$500/per child, subject to Jumpstart's other funding maximums and/or local demands and applications will be approved on a first come, first served basis.

Once you complete the process, you will be notified by email if your application has been approved. Until you receive an email indicating that the funding has been approved, please consider the submission as a request for funding only.

Typically, it takes two months to process an application.

Is there a confirmation number?

The ON number of the application they have submitted online is their reference/confirmation number.

When are applications open?

The application can be mailed in on [July 31](#), 2019 or after that date 1 month prior before the start date of the season. Applicants are able to go to www.dcfund.ca website to print the application off. ***NOTE: application must be mailed in***

Max amount anyone can receive?

No set maximum.

Are funds for registration only or team fees as well?

Both.

Where can I apply?

Only accepting online applications this year that are completed on our system. You can find this at www.laceemup.ca under the Apply tab. Any application mailed, faxed, or emailed will not be considered.

When are applications open?

Our online application opens on [June 1, 2019](#) and closes [August 15, 2019](#). We are on a first come first serve basis this year so please encourage families to apply as soon as possible as we may run out of funds later in the summer.

Max amount anyone can receive?

\$1000 we require an invoice from hockey organization showing how much a child's dues are.

Are funds for registration only or team fees as well?

Registration fees only.
